Headline is descriptive, front loaded, and a reasonable length.	
Subheads are descriptive, front loaded, and a reasonable length.	
Non-text elements have text alternatives.	
Link text uses plain English.	
Outbound links go to reputable sites.	
Paragraphs are short and top loaded.	
Bolding has been sprinkled in the text.	
Large	chunks of bolding or italics have been eliminated.
Easily	scannable auxiliary elements have been used, such as:
	Vertical lists
	Block quotes
	Pull quotes
	Tables
	Subheads
Sentences have been structure for web reading:	
	Sentences are front loaded.
	Each sentence contains one main idea.
	Active voice has been used more often than passive voice.
	Strong verbs have been used more than weak verbs.
	Needless words have been deleted.
